GENERAL ASSEMBLY

- The GENERAL ASSEMBLY of WBAA is the highest decisionmaking body.
- The regularly constituted GA is represented by all its members and has the broadest powers to take, execute or ratify all decisions taken in the interest of WBAA. The decisions taken by the GA shall be binding for all members, including the absent or dissenting ones

- The Regional Board is the decision-making and the management body. Engagement in the RB is on a voluntary basis.
